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## MERCOSUR COUNTRIES SUPPLY THEIR CONSUMERS WITH SAFE FOOD

Since the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, the food industry value chains of the MERCOSUR countries have worked in a public-privatecomprehensivemanner on the implementation of good sanitary practices to ensure the essential supply of safe food.

In order to provide transparency and security to consumers and to our marketing chains, we should like to emphasize the following:

- 1. There is no scientific evidence continuous transmission of the virus responsible for COVID-19 from animals to humans through the food chain. There is no evidence that SARS-CoV-2, which causes COVID-19, may be transmitted through foods of animal origin or plant-based food.
- 2. To date, the World Health Organization (WHO) reports that none of the studies available has linked the COVID-19 virus with contaminated surfaces of the immediate environment.
- 3. The food industry of the MERCOSUR countries implements and maintains in effect hygiene, prevention and COVID-19 risk mitigation protocols through specific contingency plans to ensure that surfaces close to food in all the points of the production chain and the final distributionuntil thelocal consumption or export ports are not contaminated, in line with world health recommendations issued by the WHO and the FAO.
- 4. The same good practices are implemented specifically in the animal protein industry in MERCOSUR countries, resulting in the healthiness and safety of the end foodstuffs sold at the domestic, regional and international level.
- 5. Health security through implementation of protocols, control and verification by public health authorities, coupled with self-control



# measures, reduce the likelihood of harmful pathogens threatening the security of essential food supply.

6. The food production chain of the MERCOSUR countries is working jointly to keep all practices updated in line with the evolution of the current and of future epidemiological events so as to ensure the safety of its foodstuffs.
